Alkali Soluble Thickener

Paragum 615 thickener is a hydrophobically modified anionic acrylic copolymer dispersion with unusually high aqueous thickening and stabilizing efficiency. It provides paints with high in-can structure and demonstrates good roller spatter resistance with a pseudoplastic (shear thinning) rheology profile. Paragum 615 is used as an "in-situ" thickener by adding directly to the material to be thickened. It can be readily prepared through neutralization with an appropriate alkali such as ammonia or caustic.

Paragum 615 thickener performs effectively in a broad range of formulations such as paints, caulks, coatings, adhesives, dispersions, and solutions. Ease of handling and processing, safety, thickening efficiency, and consistency give the formulator great latitude and flexibility in product design. When used in combination with other Paragum thickeners, an even wider range of rheological properties can be obtained.

Paragum 615 thickener solution preparation: Dilute with water, then neutralize to a pH of 7.0 to 9.0 with dilute alkali. Initial dilution of product avoids formation of gels which can be difficult to dissolve. Solutions up to about 5 % solids can be readily prepared. More concentrated solutions may require special mixing equipment or techniques.
